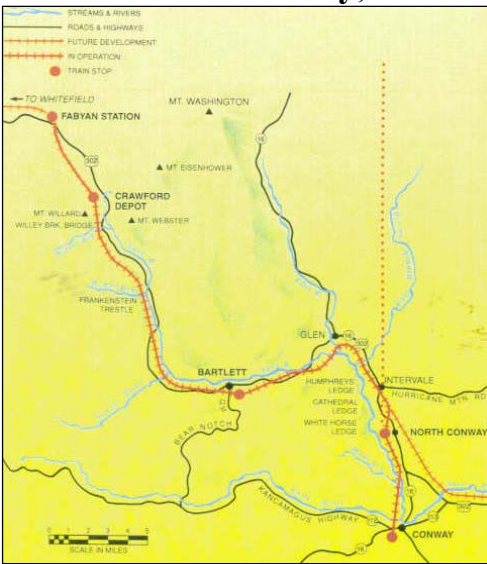




ALL ABOARD for two great trains, three unique excursions! Travel with us on one of our nostalgic train rides through the beautiful Mount Washington Valley and the surrounding White Mountains of New Hampshire. Whether you choose one of the Valley Train routes to Conway (55 minutes) or Bartlett (1 3/4 hour), or the legendary Crawford Notch Train trips (5-5 1/2 hours), you'll journey back in time, in the comfort of our open or enclosed restored passenger cars.

North Conway, NH**

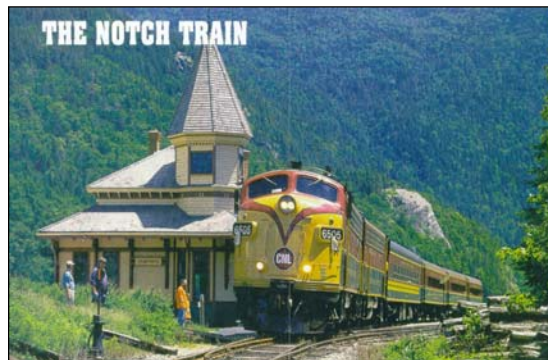


On the Valley Train, you'll depart from the historic North Conway station, passing through the countryside and mountain ranges, heading for...

Conway : This 11 mile, 55 minute roundtrip excursion travels south through farmlands, crossing Moat Brook and the Saco and Swift Rivers, to Conway, where you can watch the powerful locomotive "run-around" the train in preparation for the return trip.

Bartlett : This 21 mile, 1 3/4 hour roundtrip ride offers a longer and more relaxing excursion. Sit back as the "Valley Train" travels northwest through fields and woodlands, crossing the East Branch, Saco, and Ellis Rivers. In Bartlett, you can see the locomotive "run around" the train for the return trip to North Conway.

Train, you'll enjoy some of the the East as you travel through Notch - past sheer bluffs, steep brooks and streams, panoramic mountain vistas, and across the famed Frankenstein Trestle and Willey Brook Bridge, enroute to Crawford Depot or Fabyan Station. The Crawford Notch excursion allows you the opportunity to re-live a legend of railroad history, when the first train traveled through Crawford Notch over 120 years ago. Live commentary includes history and folklore of the railroad and area, as well as other points of interest.



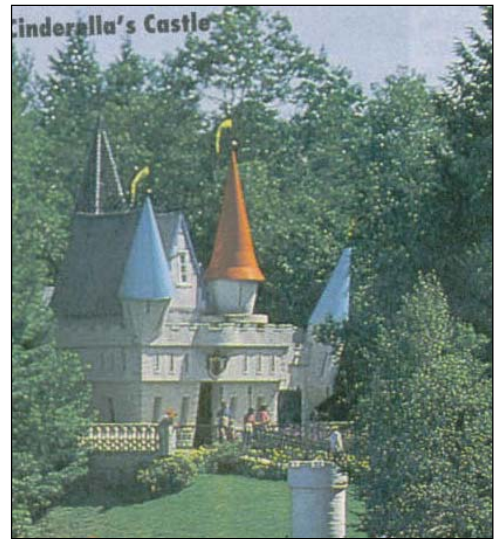
On the Notch finest natural scenery in spectacular Crawford ravines, cascading

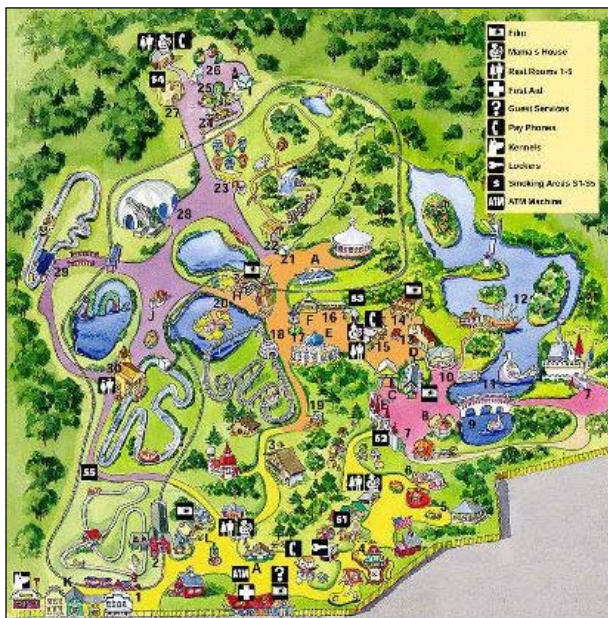

Farther down the path you'll find the Buccaneer Pirate Ship Play Area, The Race Of The Horses and our one of a kind Shooting Gallery that features the biggest cameras in our Mexican Village! If you need to cool off, don't miss the Oceans Of Fun Spray-ground that centers around a huge interactive Submarine Play Station.
